Thank you to everyone who attended and completed the online survey. If you would still like to complete it you can find it on the Ofsted Parent View site.

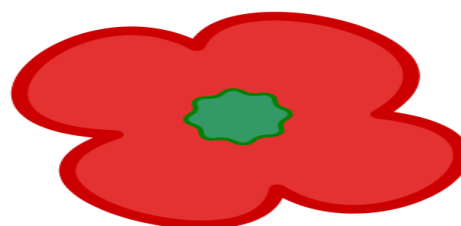
We had an overwhelmingly positive response to the parents evening. If you have any queries or suggestions, please do not hesitate to speak to Mrs Dodd.
