It was an absolute honour to welcome Dame Mary – the children were fascinated learning about her life and inspired by the many ways that she has worked to change the world for the better.



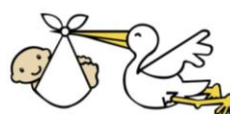
Cricket Workshop
