Covid Testing School

We are delighted to have been selected to be a **testing school** for Public Health England. Every child and staff member will get the chance to be tested for both Covid 19 and for antibodies 6 times between November and June next year.

The full details of the study have been sent out by email. You need to register your child if you would like them to be tested as part of the study – no one will be forced to be tested. The link to the testing is not live yet, but will be sent to you early next week.

The testing will inform us whether anyone in school has Covid19, is asymptomatic or whether they have antibodies. We hope that by most of our school family taking the test, we will keep school an even safer place to be.

If children or staff are identified as having the virus, even if they are asymptomatic, we can ask them to isolate which will prevent potential spread of the disease.

The tests are very simple and NOT like the tests that are carried out at testing centres. The antibody test is taken by sucking on a spong lollipop. The Covid test is taken by a low swab, just inside the nostril, with a swab resembling a cotton bud.
