Attendance this week = 97.4%

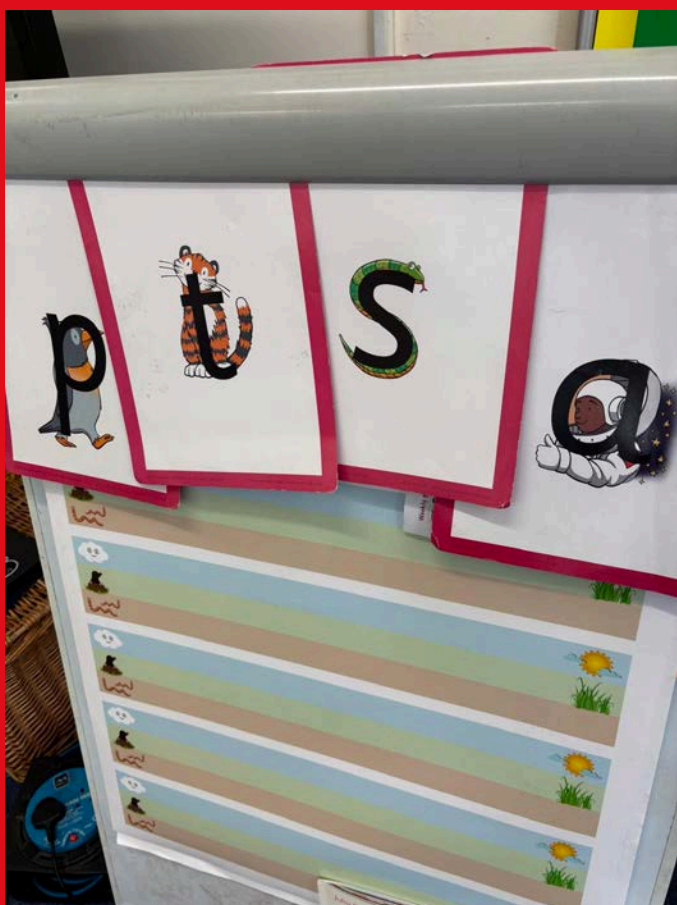

Victoria has enjoyed starting our Letters and Sounds sessions this week.

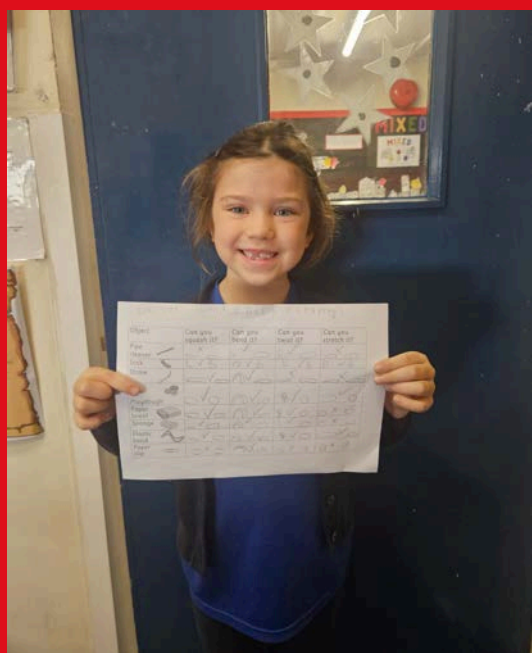

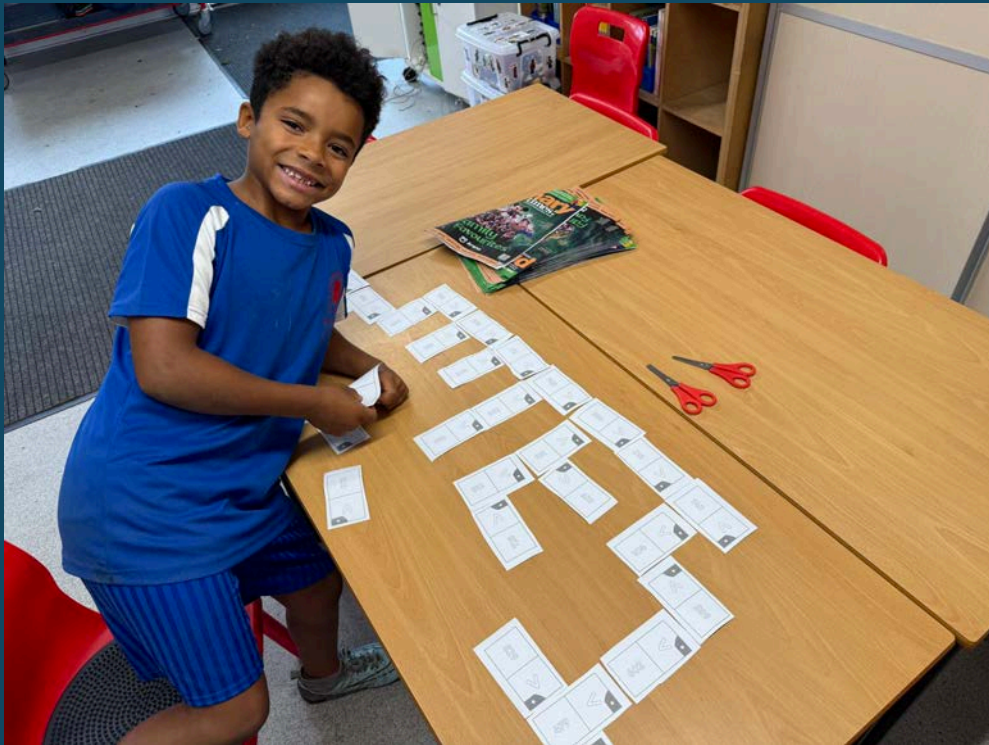
Amber and Archie have enjoyed doing maths this week, especially doing the one more and one less practical activity using conkers.

Millie has enjoyed learning all about Amelia Earhart in History. Bobbi has enjoyed investigating the different materials and whether she could change the shape or not.

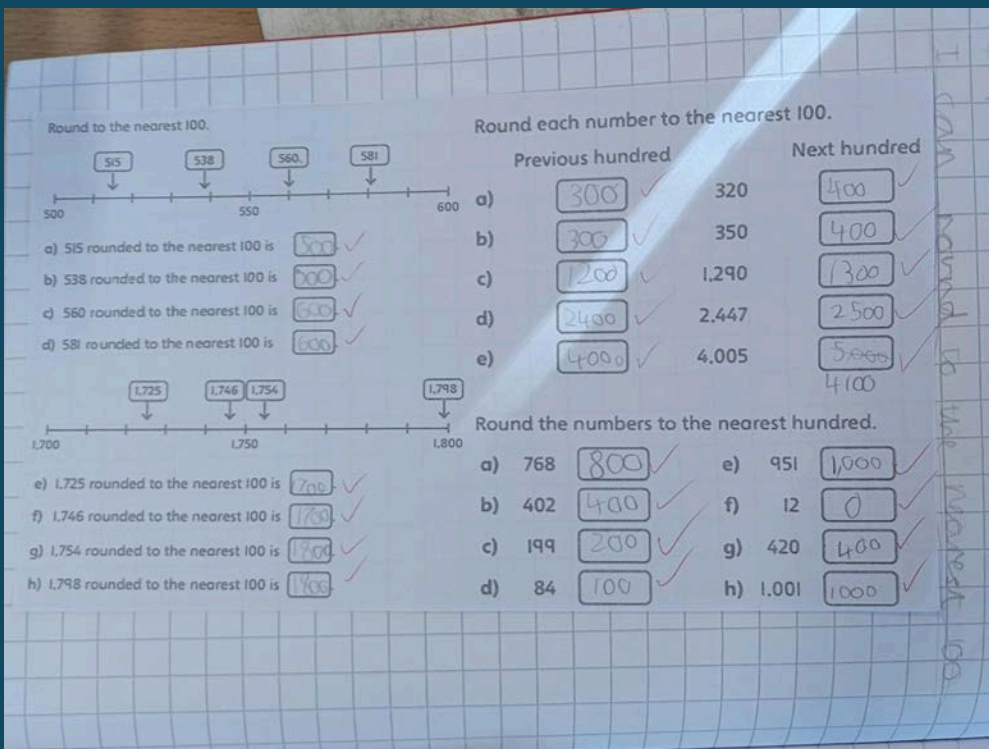

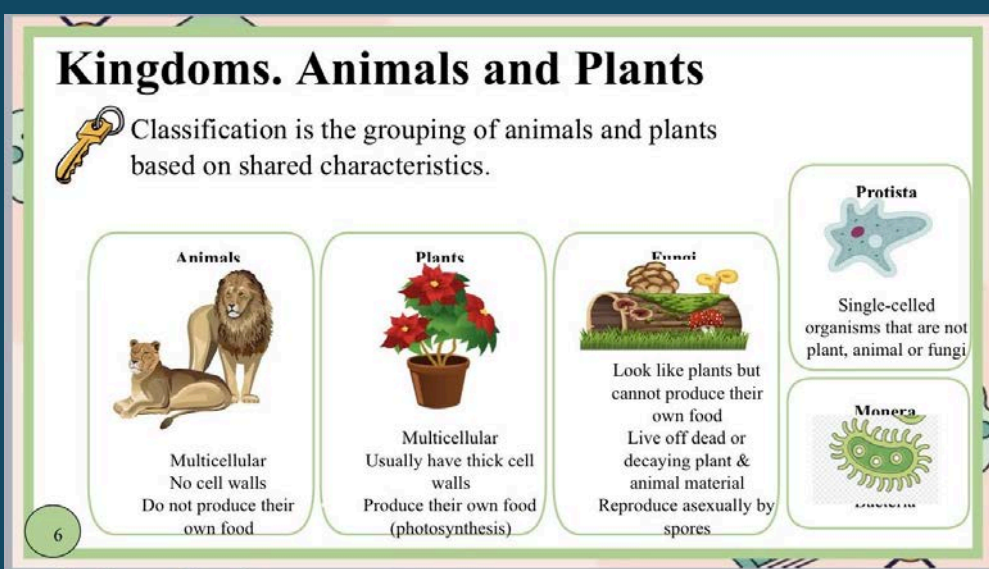
