### School lunch booking on ParentPay

You may have noticed on ParentPay that there is an option to choose and book your child's school lunch. This at present is being piloted by Reception and Year 1 and will be rolled out to the whole school in due course, however we will keep you informed.

It will be available to book up to 3 weeks in advance with a cut off being midnight the night before. You will be able to see the menu choice for each day.

### Free School Meals or Pupil Premium

If you are now claiming Universal Credit you may be entitled to FSM. If your household income is below £7400 (not including benefits), you should be entitled.

School receives additional funding for each child who is on FSM and this allows us to keep staffing levels really high so that children can be supported in small groups.

This year we are also going to offer £50 of school credit for all pupils who are currently receiving FSM. This credit can be used for school trips, before and after school care as well as after-school clubs.

It is very easy to apply, if your child is Year 3 and above, you need to complete an application form. If your child is in Reception, Yr1 or Yr 2, all we need is your full name, NI number and DOB and we can check for you.
