## Wrap around Care

Wrap around care runs every day in term time from 7.30am in the morning until 6pm at night in the school hall. Places can be booked using ParentPay. You only pay for the sessions that you use and you are welcome to book on at the last minute if you are delayed for any reason.

£10.50 per after school session

There are places left in all clubs except Musical Theatre, KS2 Tennis and Cookery.

All clubs start next week and will run up until Christmas.

If you have booked and paid for a club on ParentPay, your child has been given the place at the club. ParentPay will not accept bookings if a club is full.

If anyone is experiencing difficulty paying for a club, please speak to Mrs Dodd in confidence. We want **all** children to be able to attend the clubs that we offer.
