Dear Parents,

Here are the suggested ideas for home learning. It is suggested that all children complete these activities whilst the children are working from home.

The expectation is that children complete:

30 minutes of Maths Whizz/TT Rockstars/LBQ/My Maths

30 minutes/2 stories from Reading Plus/Oxford Reading Buddies/Comprehension activity

Completion of daily English activity - sometimes linked to topic

And often, a topic based activity e.g. Art/DT/History/Science/French etc

The idea of the mixture of tasks is to give the children work that is electronic and practical. Feel free to create your own - taking this opportunity to get creative (Lego, cake making, filming etc!).

The children will benefit from routine and therefore we would recommend making a timetable, which includes the expectations above whilst also including time for exercise, play and creativity.
