Subject	Topic / theme	What can be done at home or brought to school	Key Vocabulary
English	Reading and understanding what they have read.	Read at least 3 times per week with your child. Ask questions about the text. Encourage the children to read for enjoyment!	
	Narrative	We looking at books by Benji Davis. Read books by similar authors and look at how we can describe settings and characters.	Plot, character, setting
	Non-chronological report	Look at examples of non-chronological reports and how they are structured	Title, sub-heading, labels, captions, technical vocabulary.
Maths	Fractions	Examine fractions of shape, objects, chocolate, pizza etc! Find fractions of amounts. Compare fractions with different denominators	Equivalent, numerator, denominator.
	Time	Help the children to tell the time digitally and use an analogue clock.	Hours, minutes, seconds.
	Shape and direction	Different 2D and 3D shapes. Learn their properties.	
Science	Animals (including nutrition)	Look at the different food groups that humans need. Examine the different bones and muscles in the human body.	Carbohydrates, proteins, vitamins and minerals, fats. Muscles. Skeletons.
History	Egypt	Look at the history of the Egyptians. Read (and watch) books about the Egyptians. Take the children to the museum.	
Computing	Branching databases	Play Guess Who with the children to encourage effective questioning (yes and no questions). Look at branching databases.	Program, Debug, Algorithm.
P.E.	Cricket	Practise throwing, catching and batting.
