Snacks

As from Monday, children will choose what snack they would like for the whole week rather than choosing each day as it is taking up valuable time in class.

The cost is 50p per day and we offer Toast with either Juice, Milk or Water.

Reception parents – please note as they are part-time this week and next, school snack will be available week beginning 21st September when your child is full-time

We are aware there have been some issues with our new lunch and snack system, please bear with us while we try to rectify these little problems. Thank you

WRAPAROUND CARE – All Stars

We have full wrap around open for all children. You only pay for the sessions that you need and use – these can be different each week or even booked at the last minute if you find that you are stuck in traffic or in a meeting.

Breakfast care costs £3.50 per day and opens at 7.30am. After-school Wraparound costs £10.00 per day and runs until 6pm – both must be booked in advance on ParentPay. If you have any problems booking, please contact the school office.

AFTER-SCHOOL CLUBS

We hope to be able to offer some after school clubs in the coming weeks however there will be no residential trips until next academic year.

Free School Meals

If you are now claiming Universal Credit you may be entitled to FSM. School receives additional funding for each child who is on FSM and this allows us to keep staffing levels really high so that children can be supported in small groups.

This year we are also going to offer £50 of school credit for all pupils who are currently receiving FSM. This credit can be used for school trips, before and after school care as well as after-school clubs.

It is very easy to apply, we can do it for you, all we need is your full name, NI number and DOB.
