



Coronavirus

The symptoms of coronavirus are:

Cough, high temperature, shortness of breath

But these symptoms do not necessarily mean you have the illness. The symptoms are similar to other illnesses that are much more common, such as cold and flu.

NHS 111 has an online coronavirus service that can tell you if you need medical help and advise you what to do. Use this service if:

- you think you might have coronavirus
- you've been to Cambodia, China, Hong Kong, northern Italy, Iran, Japan, Laos, Macau, Malaysia, Myanmar (Burma), Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan, Thailand or Vietnam in the past 14 days
- you've been in close contact with someone with coronavirus

If there's a chance you could have coronavirus, you may be asked to stay away from other people (self-isolate).

Please inform school if you think that you or any of your family members may have been in contact with someone who has the symptoms of the virus or have travelled to an affected area.

The advice given is that schools do not need to close. We will update you regularly if there are any changes to the current advice.
