Our school is currently experiencing the highest numbers of cases locally which Is why some other school are going ahead with their performances and we have had to change our arrangements.

We are filming the KS1 Nativity Play so that all families have a chance to view it at home safely. We will refund all the tickets ASAP and the live shows will not go ahead. We are very sorry for any disappointment caused, but we had sold 3 tickets per child so potentially this could have been 300+ contacts in a relatively small space.

We will still have Decoration Day for the children, but we will not be able to welcome parents into school. This has been decided with a very heavy heart as it is our favourite day of the year, however we cannot do this in a safe enough way this year with the rising case numbers that we are experiencing.

The Tree Service has now been limited by the Church to a maximum of 70 visitors. We have made the decision to just take Y2 (as they are missing out on their last chance to take part in a Nativity performance)

Our Christmas Fair will still go ahead as it is being held outside on the Muga pitch. Our school raffle has a whole host of wonderful prizes - tickets can be bought on Parent Pay if you wish to support school.

The children will still have all of their Christmas parties in their classes. KS1 and KS2 will have a magic show, classes will be distanced in the Hall with adequate ventilation, to keep them as safe as possible.

We will still have our school Christmas dinner but not together as a whole school.
