## **SATS** results

## Our Year 6 children have performed amazingly well – again!

97% gained the expected grade in Reading – the national grade was 75% - we are 22% higher than the national average

87% gained the expected grade in Maths – the national grade was 76% - we are 11% above the national average

87% gained the expected grade in Writing – the national grade was 78% - we are 9% above national average

Our progress measures also look outstanding – although these will not be officially confirmed until national progress data is released.

We are absolutely delighted with these results – they are a testament to seven years of strong teaching, the support given from families and the hard work and positive attitudes that our children have.
