Virtual Maths Week

Last week over 160 children took part in our first ever Virtual Maths Week and completed over 700 different Maths tasks! They practiced a range of Maths skills including measuring, shape work, number bonds, arrays, investigations, data handling and much more.

32 children achieved a Gold Award, 10 children achieved a Silver Award and 81 children achieved a Bronze Award. The hundreds of photographs and videos that were sent in to us celebrated all their hard work.

Year 5 achieved the most awards. Year 2 received the most Gold awards. Harvey in Year 5 and Poppy in Year 4 have been highly commended for their outstanding work.

Return to school in September

All primary school children in England will return to school full time in September. A new risk assessment is currently being completed to ensure that we offer the safest possible environment as the children return. This will be shared next week.

WRAPAROUND CARE FROM SEPT:

We can confirm that we will be offering before and after school care from the first day back. Breakfast care is £3.50 per day and After-school Wraparound is £10.00 per day – both must be booked in advance on ParentPay.

AFTER-SCHOOL CLUBS FROM SEPT:

We hope to be able to offer some after school clubs and some non- residential trips in line with government guidance. This has not been finalised as yet but we will let you know more in September.

School meals

The cost of a daily school lunch is £2.40 per day and will **NOT** increase in September. Lunch includes a hot meal, drink and biscuit. Snacks are 50p per day and includes toast and either milk, water or juice. Crumpets will no longer be available on a snack

Reading challenge

This year's summer reading challenge is all taking place online and the children will need to sign up to 'Join the Silly Squad' and take part.

They can then pick their own Avatar, discover books to read, play games, earn points and unlock badges throughout the challenges. The children can read any books of their choosing including ebooks on our school Oxford Reading Buddy account.
