## **SEND PROVISION DURING THE SUMMER TERM**

To support our SEND provision during the Summer Term, we are very fortunate to have Miss Kerr joining us as our interim Senco. Miss Kerr is an experienced Senco from Brook Acre Primary, one of our partner schools within the One Community Trust and she has already spent time with Mrs Gorman and met many of our children to ensure a smooth transition. During the first half of the term, she will be with us for one and a half days each week while continuing to teach Year 6 at Brook Acre. Following SATs, she will increase her time with us to four days a week. Miss Kerr will be fully supported by our dedicated Culcheth Primary SEND team - myself, Miss Edwards, Miss Arnold, Miss McGrail, Mrs McCord, Miss Lloyd and Miss Isles - to ensure continuity and a seamless handover ahead of the appointment of our permanent Senco.

# REACH MORE PARENTS

After listening to feedback from a number of parents since September we realise that parents were finding it difficult to manage all of the different communications systems that we have in school and some are having difficulty with School Ping. Therefore we have made the decision to switch to REACH MORE PARENTS during the Easter break.

We are asking parents to download the REACH MORE PARENTS app on to their mobile device. You have been directly emailed your own log in then for this app and code. It will then allow you to create your own password.

We have chosen Reach More Parents because it will literally become a one stop place for parental communication. Once you have logged into the app it will give you a page for each child you have at the school. The app will:

Show your child's attendance

Allow you to report absences

Show a targeted school calendar

Show a targeted newsfeed of events in school

Include link to Parent Pay

Include links to apps your child uses in school, e.g. Spelling Shed, Reading Plus, Times Table Rockstars, etc.

Allow you to message the office.

Allow the school to send you messages that you can automatically authorise, e.g. permission to give your child Calpol etc.

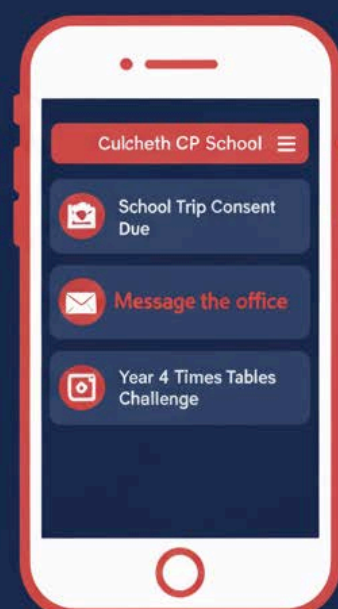

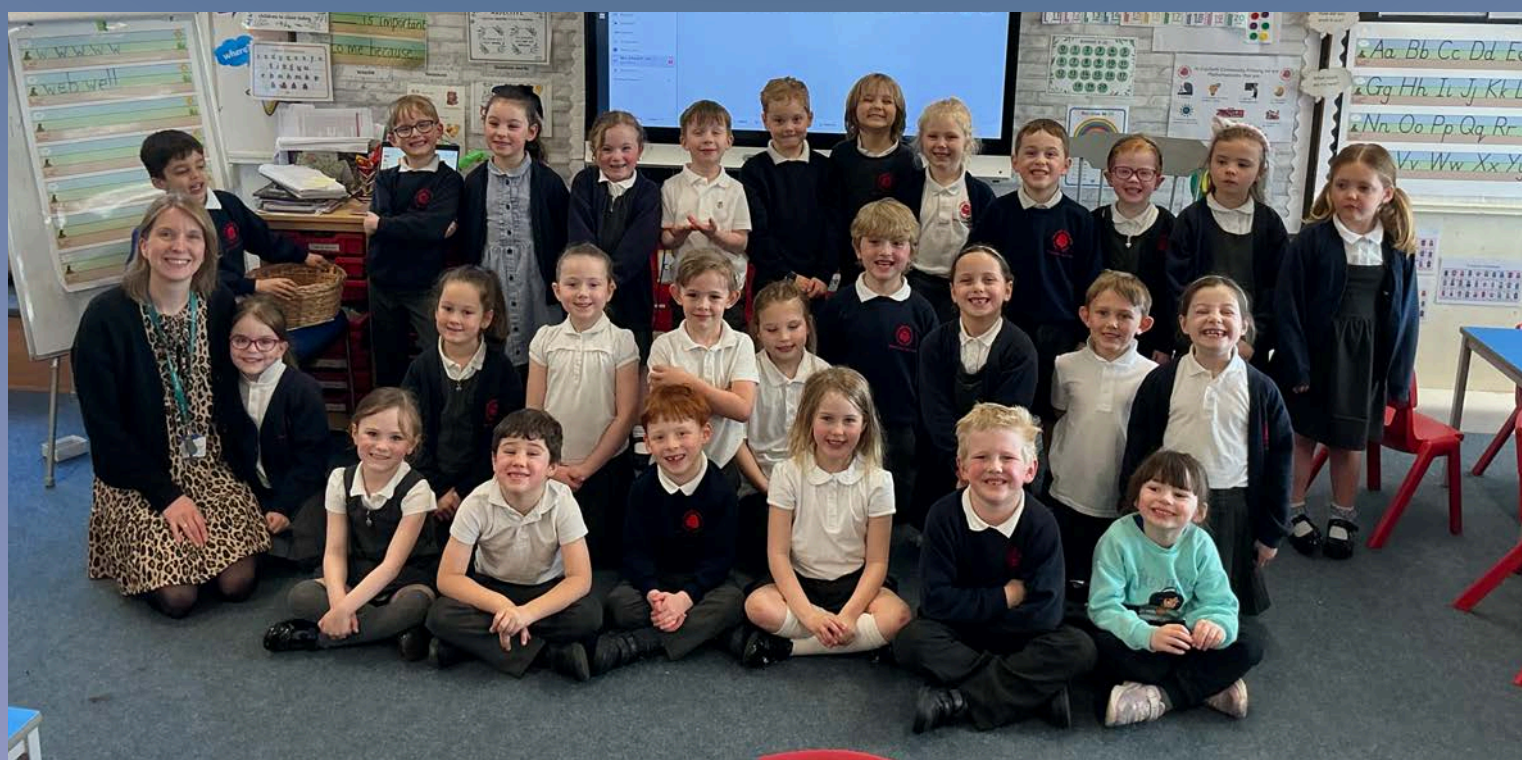

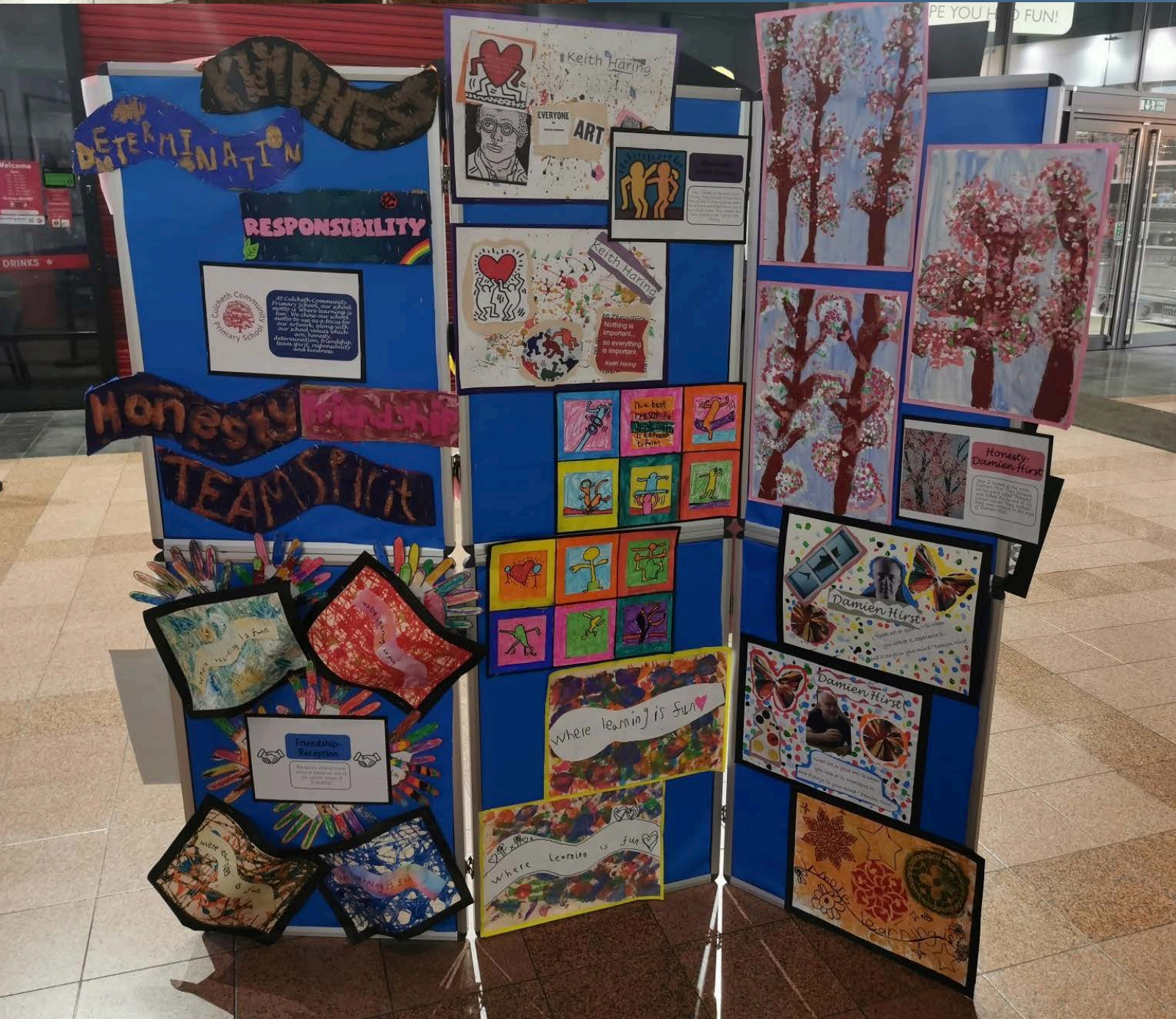


# PAN EXHIBIT GOLDEN SQUARE

<b>All of EYFS</b>	<p><i>Kindness- Reception have worked hard on looking out for anyone who is on their own during break and lunchtimes and have used 'Kind Words' to check that those children are OK and to ask them if they would like to play.</i></p> <p><i>Team Spirit – The children have worked hard this half term to encourage and help each other to achieve their goals, no matter how small and have learnt that working together as a team gets the job done quicker.</i></p> <p><i>Responsibility – In Reception the children have learnt a lot about responsibility this half term whilst hatching and looking after our 8 chicks and looking after our caterpillars.</i></p> <p><i>Determination – All of Reception have given 100% effort at trying to write on our smaller 'Sky, Grass and Soil' writing frames, it hasn't been easy but the children have persevered every morning and with their determination they have seen a huge improvement.</i></p> <p><i>Friendship – Reception have continued with a 'Friendship Friday' this half term, where the children can choose who they line up and sit next to for their lunch on a Friday, and they have worked hard to try and earn this reward each week.</i></p> <p><i>Honesty – Reception have joined in with some super discussions during 'Talk Circle' times about the importance of telling the truth and are beginning to understand the difference between telling a 'Tale' and telling a 'Lie'.</i></p>
<b>All of Year 1</b>	<p><i>Kindness- Year one has shown kindness this half term by helping their classmates, sharing resources, and using thoughtful words to make everyone feel included and valued.</i></p> <p><i>Team Spirit – We have shown great team spirit this half term by working together, supporting one another, and celebrating each other's success as a class.</i></p> <p><i>Responsibility – The children have shown fantastic team spirit this half term by cooperating in group activities, encouraging their classmates, and working together to achieve shared goals.</i></p> <p><i>Determination – Year one has shown determination in their first assessments and has tried their best.</i></p> <p><i>Friendship – We are a team, and we work together in everything we do, being kind and considerate to each other, and using our My Happy Minds to be mindful of one another and considerate of everyone.</i></p> <p><i>Honesty - Year one have shown honesty this half term by telling the truth, taking responsibility for their actions and being trustworthy in their learning and play.</i></p>

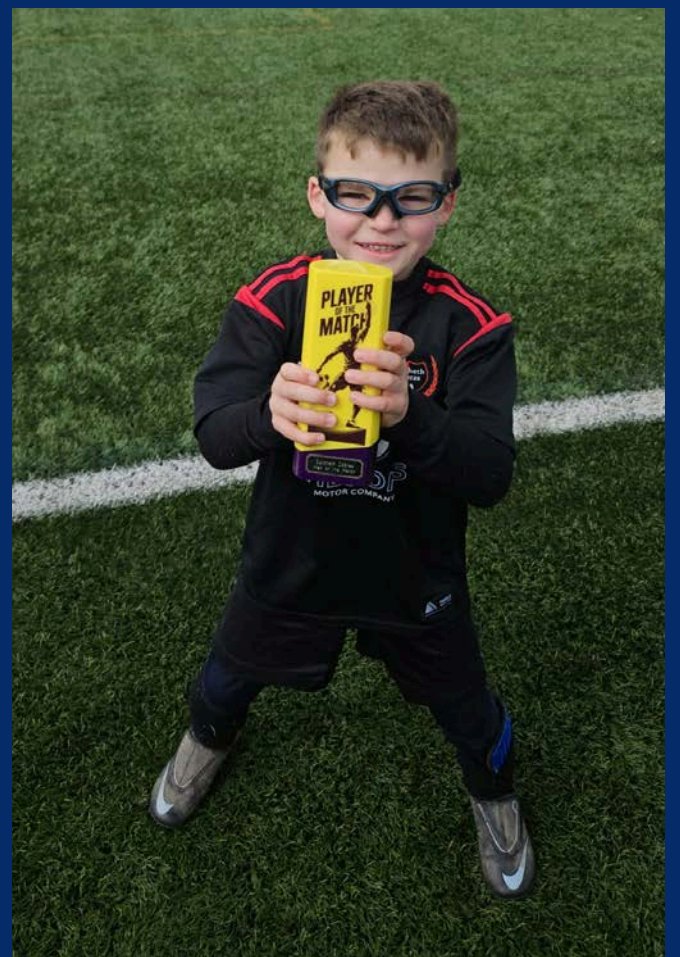

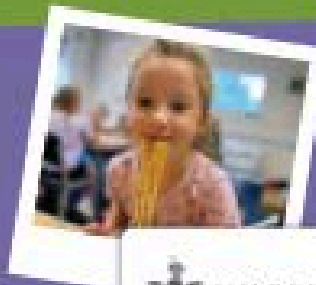
